Produced in partnership with Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization's (CYMPO) member agencies, the Central Yavapai Active Community Transportation-Unified Plan (ACT-UP) aims to help develop a nonmotorized transportation network that links communities, provides travel options, and supports broader regional health, mobility, and equity goals. Working with local jurisdictions, ACT-UP will help improve, expand, and connect the region's active transportation system.

The plan will improve the network by:



Identifying networks of bicycle routes and improved bicycle facilities



Focusing on safe walking access.



Identifying connections to transit facilities.




Enhancing connectivity to off-street trails.
