

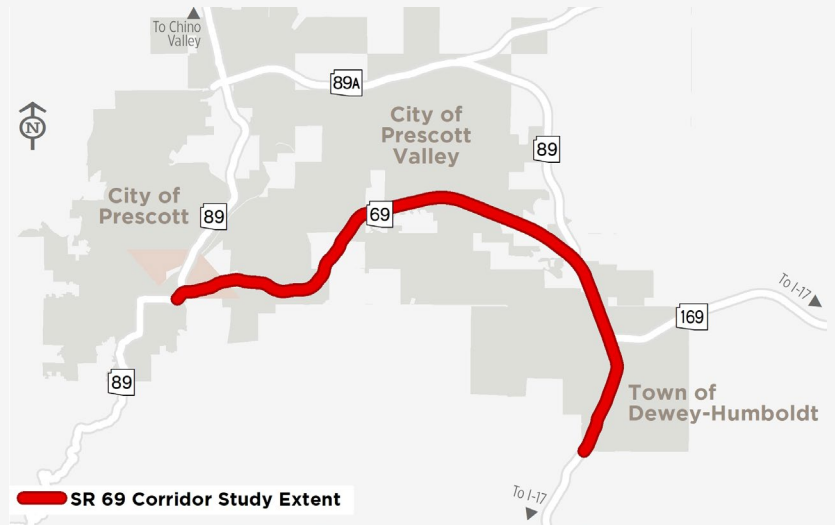


STATE ROUTE 69 CORRIDOR MASTER PLAN

PLAN OVERVIEW

As the backbone of the region’s transportation system, State Route 69 (SR 69) is a vital connection between major activity centers, residential areas, and other regional routes in the Central Yavapai Region. Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization (CYMPO), local communities, Yavapai County, and the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) are working together to develop a planning strategy to improve the mobility and safety along the State Route 69 from the Dewey Humboldt town limits to SR 89 in Prescott.
